The bid document references the following, “furnish and install (9) card access readers that work with State ID cards along with 50 spare cards to work with the system”. Are these State ID cards used for any other access control system?</p> <p>A: <u>Yes, the state ID cards are already chipped to work within the Judiciary.</u> (The state id’s can be programmed to work in many of the DGS buildings.)</p>
