

IN THE COURT OF APPEALS OF MARYLAND
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AMENDING THE STATE JOINT TRAVEL REGULATIONS
FOR THE JUDICIAL BRANCH OF GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, By Administrative Order, dated April 8, 2014, the State Joint Travel Regulations for the Judicial Branch of Government ("State Joint Travel Regulations") were amended, in their entirety, effective May 1, 2014, to amplify and clarify them; and

WHEREAS, It is, once again, necessary to amend the State Joint Travel Regulations, in their entirety, to amplify and clarify them.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY ELLEN BARBERA, Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals and Administrative Head of the Judicial Branch, pursuant to the authority conferred by Article IV, § 18 of the Maryland Constitution; Article 8 of the Declaration of Rights; and § 1-706 of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article, do hereby this 1st day of August, 2014, effective the 1st day of August, 2014, amend the State Joint Travel Regulations, as hereinafter provided, for all travel authorized by the regulations occurring on and after the 1st day of August, 2014.

Effective the 1st day of August, 2014, the Administrative Order establishing travel regulations for personnel of the Judicial Branch covered by the regulations, dated April 8, 2014, is rescinded.
