O R D E R

It is ORDERED by me, Chief Judge Stedman Prescott of the Court of Appeals of Maryland, this 5<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1965, that the Judges' Quarterly Reports, heretofore filed quarterly with the Administrative Office of the Courts under the authority of Article IV, Section 18A of the Constitution of Maryland, be, and they are hereby, discontinued, and it is

Further ORDERED that in lieu thereof each judge of the circuit courts and of the several courts of Baltimore City shall file with the Administrative Office of the Courts, within the first ten (10) days of the months of February, April, June, August, October and December, on such form as may be furnished by the Administrative Office, a report disclosing the courts in which said judge has been engaged other than the court of the residence of said judge; and in addition all undecided cases, motions and demurrers held sub curia for more than thirty (30) days. If any such matter has been held sub curia for more than sixty (60) days, the report shall include the title thereof, the date of hearing, and the reasons why decision is being reserved.
