ORDER

It appearing that the Client Protection Fund of the Bar of Maryland certified to the Court the name of LLOYD DAVID IGLEHART as an attorney who was purportedly in default in payment of annual assessments, and documentation in the form of a death certificate, having been received by the Fund subsequent to the certification of default indicating that Mr. Iglehart passed away on October 14, 2013; it is therefore, this 19th day of May, 2014

ORDERED, by the Court of Appeals of Maryland, that the above mentioned Order of March 20, 2014 be, and it is hereby, rescinded as to the attorney listed above, and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the clerks of the Court of Special Appeals, the several circuit courts of the counties and Baltimore City and the Chief Clerk of the District Court.
