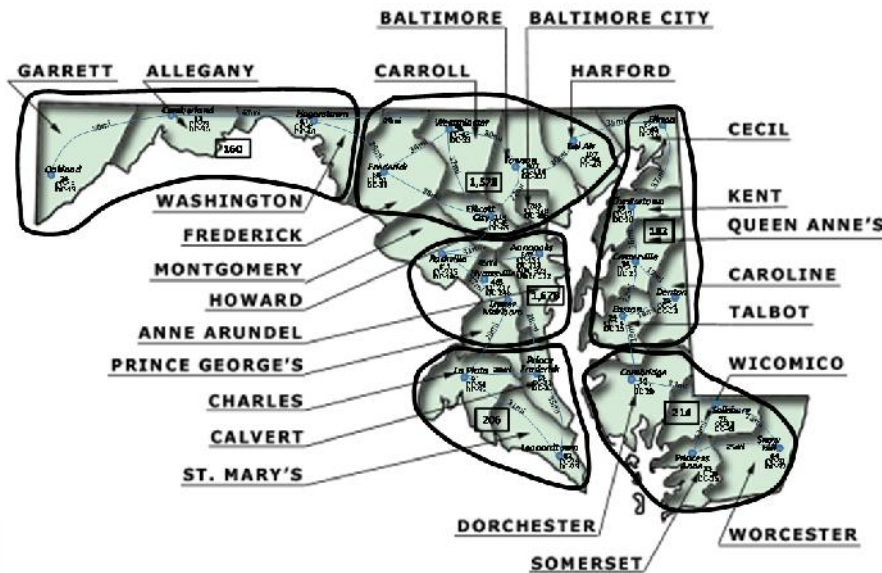
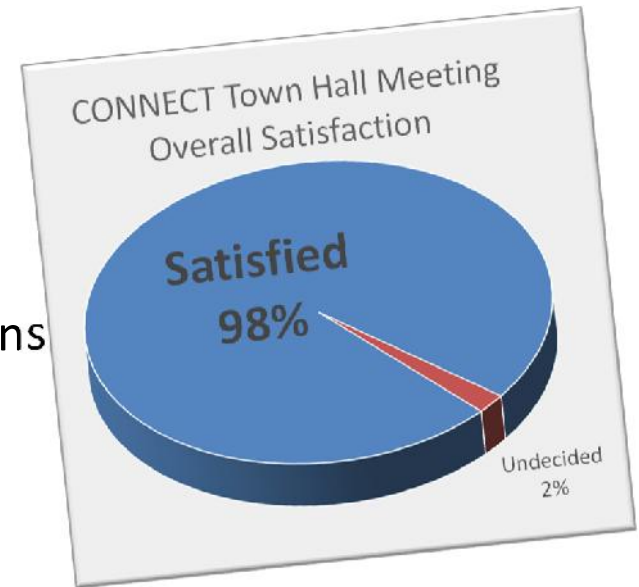
Power Users prior to and following Go Live

Our first in-person communication efforts were a HUGE success!

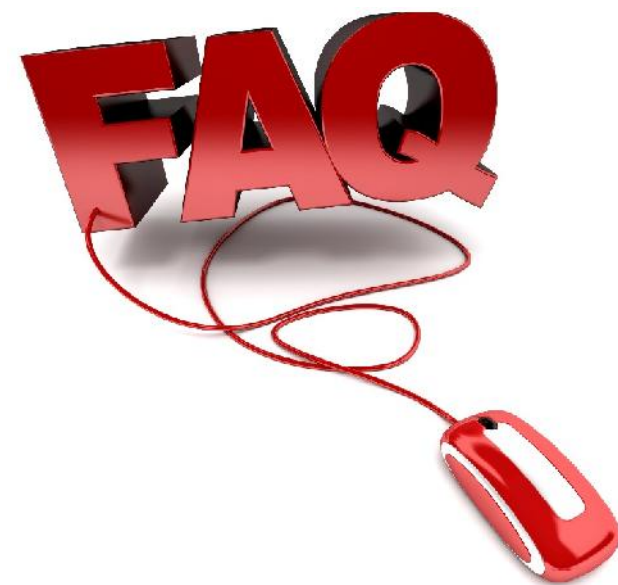
 Over 500 employees attended

- > 95% would like to attend more CONNECT sessions



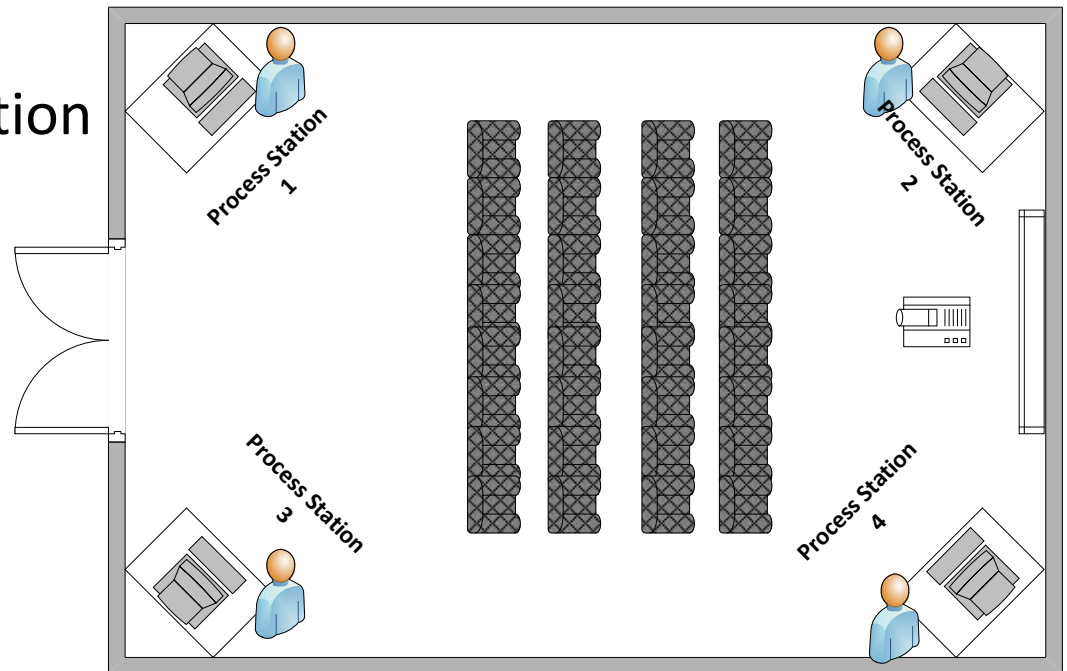
Hundreds of great questions were asked and answered on the spot!

 - > Street Fairs in early November



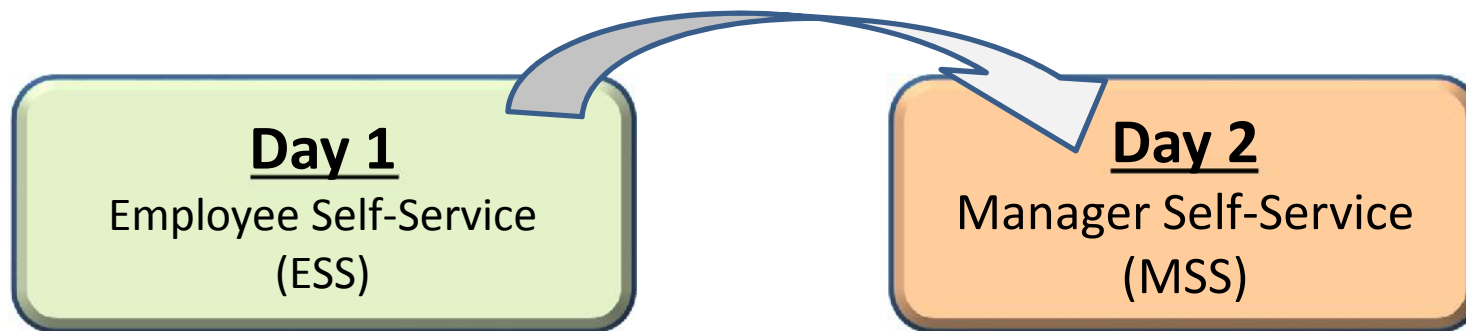
Street Fairs will be our first unveiling of CONNECT functionality.

- Tentatively planned for last two weeks of July in several locations (TBD)

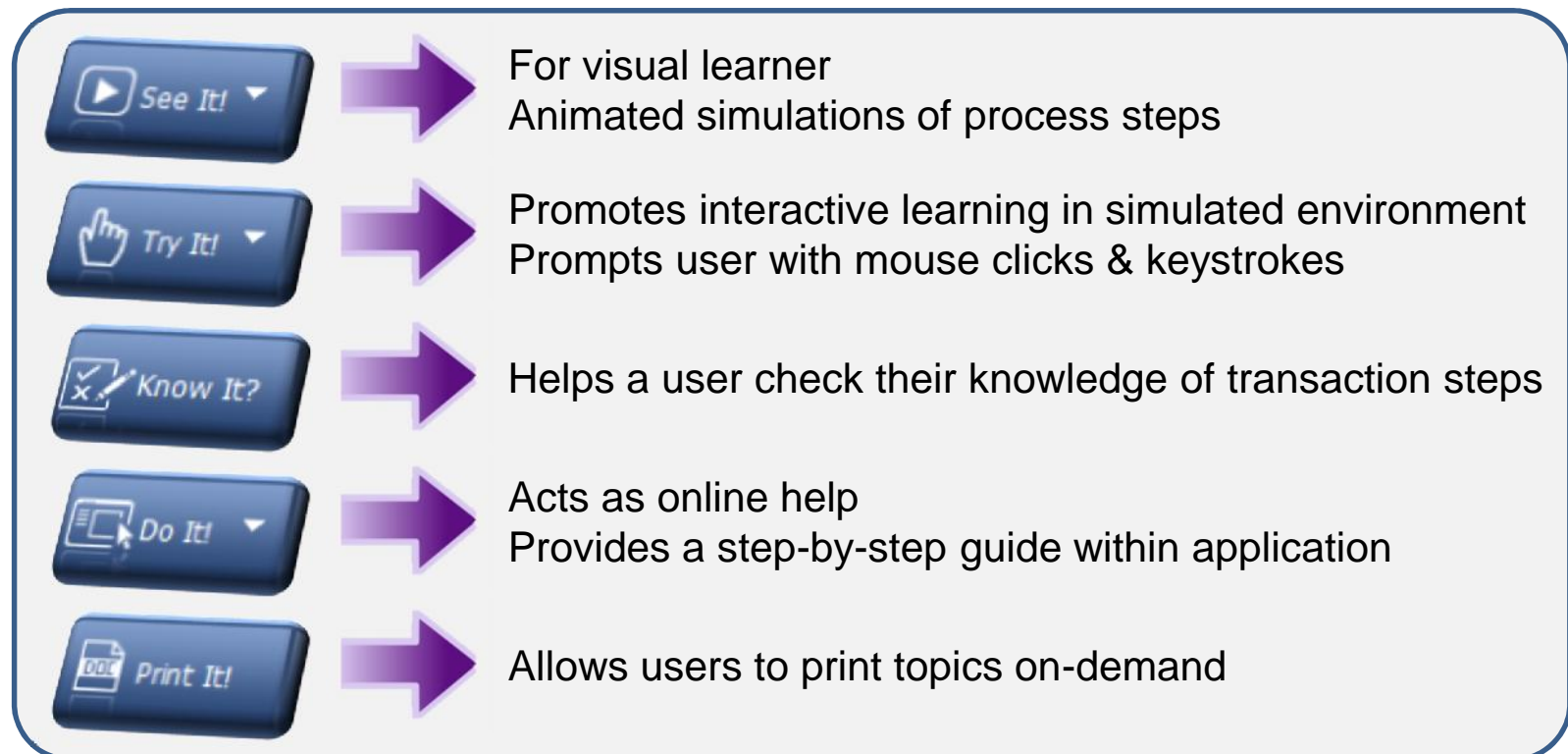


Training will be web-based through online lessons for most Judiciary employees.

- All employees will have access to online courses
- CONNECTors will receive classroom training
 - > End-to-end process training for ESS & MSS
 - > 2-Day sessions at JECC



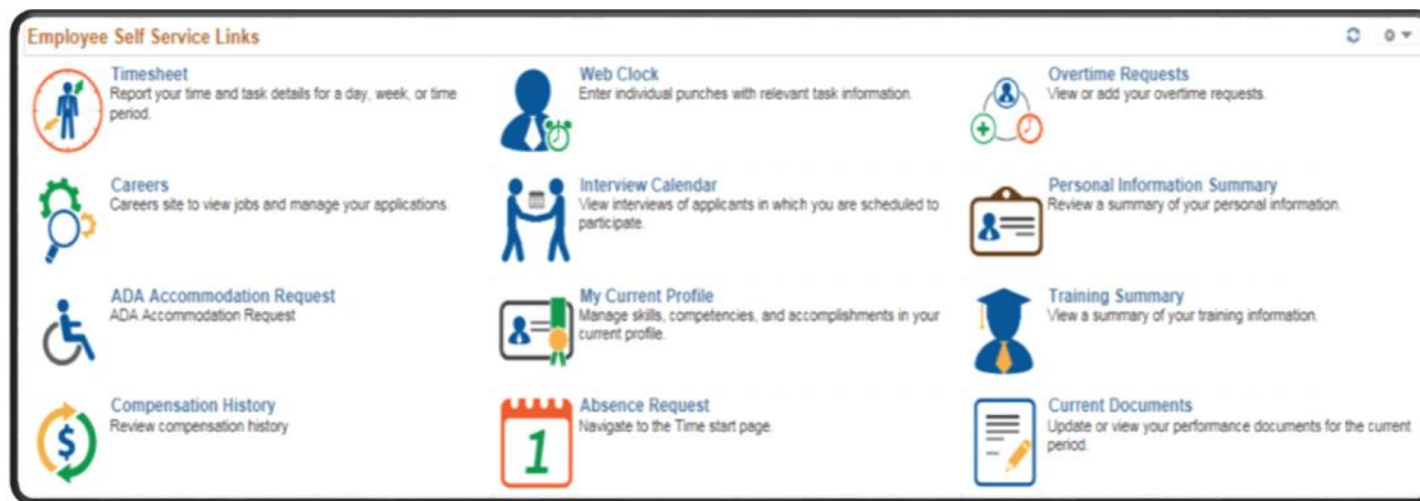
User Productivity Kit (UPK) records processes, develops simulations, & produces web-based online training for multiple training delivery options.

CONNECT is more than just timesheets

- > Leave request & balance checks
- > Personal information updates
- > Education & Training registration
- > Performance management activities
- > Online training access

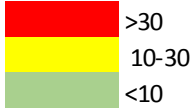
- Timesheet**: Report your time and task details for a day, week, or time period.

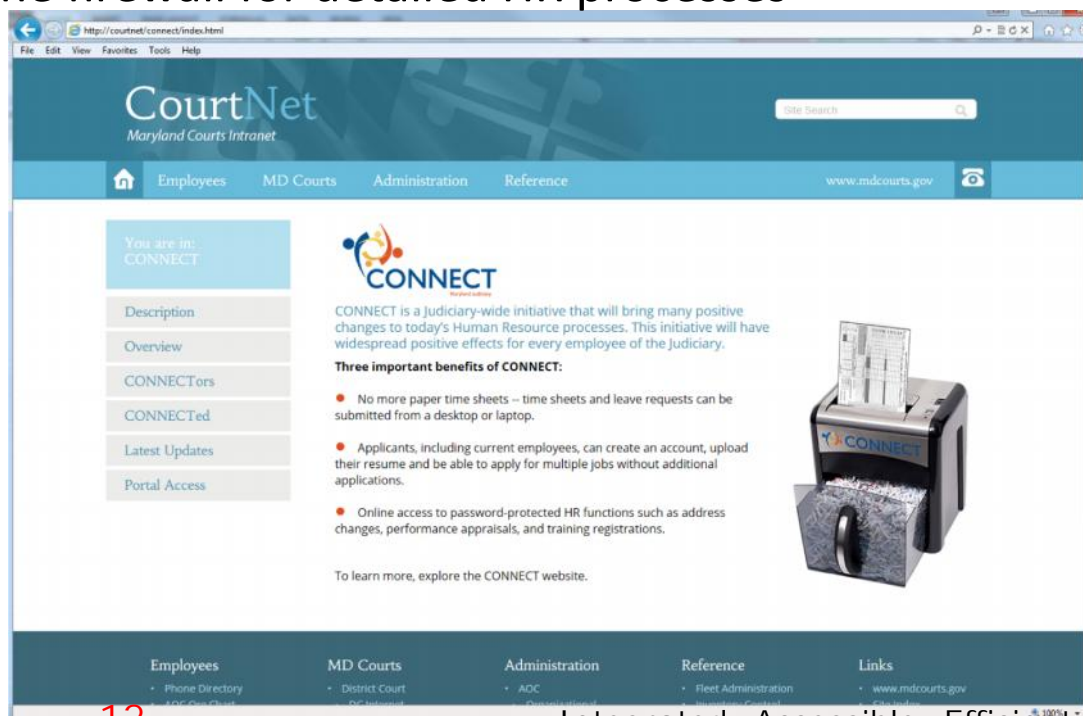

- > CONNECT access through the firewall for detailed HR processes



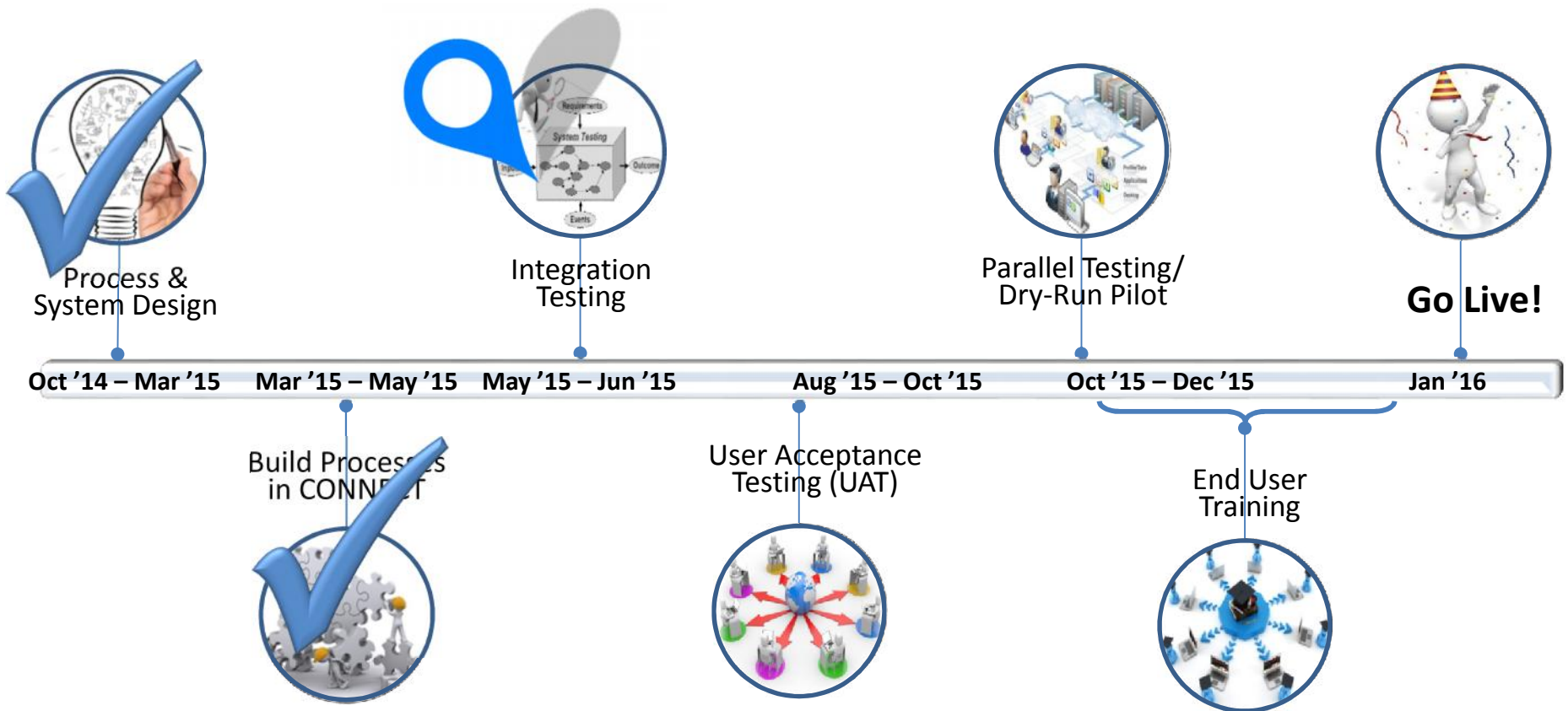
You might have it and not even know it.

 - > CONNECT / JIS information request & onsite checks



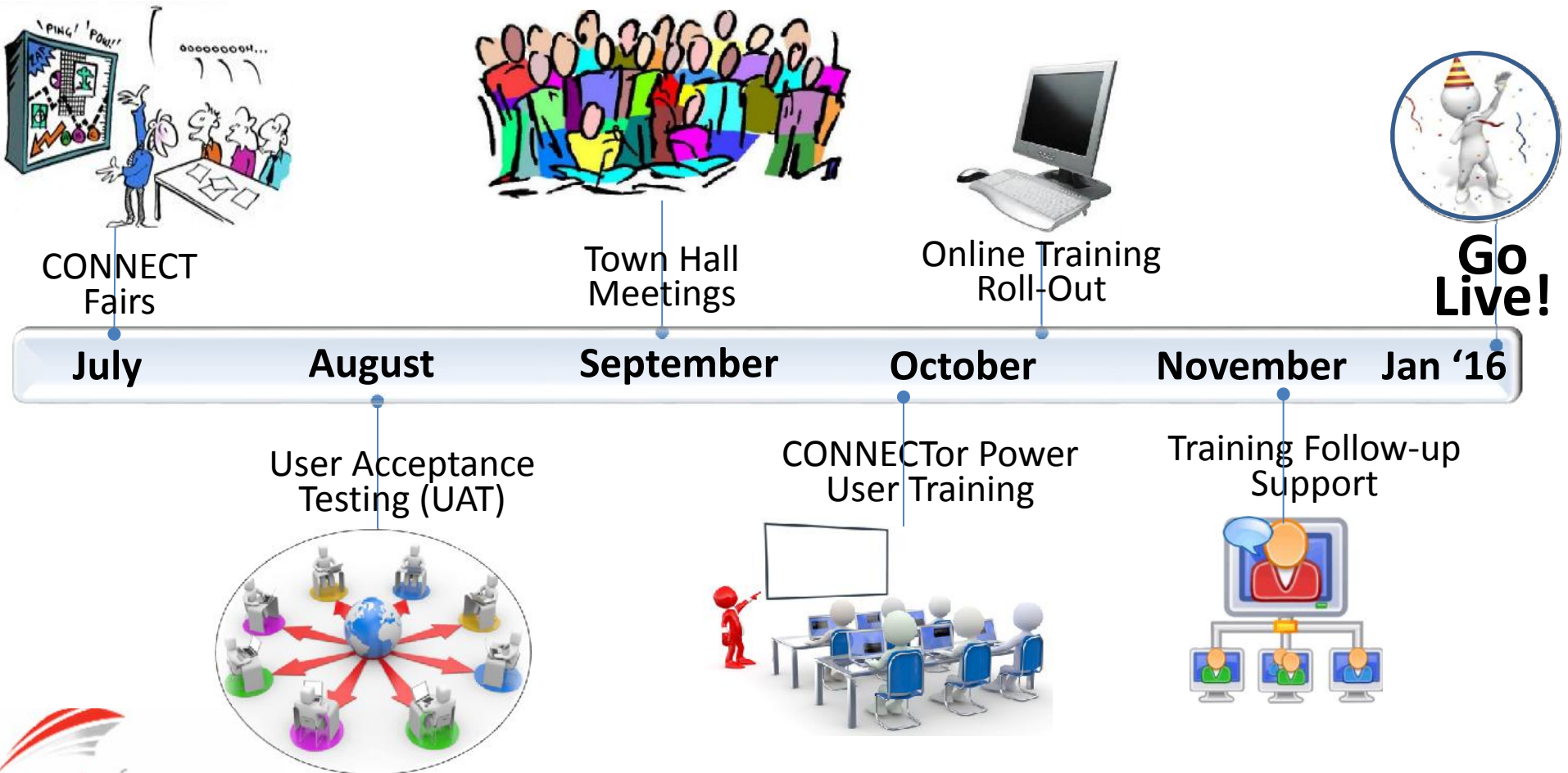
