## JUDICIAL COUNCIL WORKGROUP ON THE STATE OF THE COURT REPORTS

The Judicial Council's Workgroup on the State of the Court Reports is tasked with reviewing the annual reports submitted by the trial courts. The reports provide an overview of the work of the courts during Calendar Year 2015, as well as the courts' goals for Calendar Year 2016. Additionally, the reports contain information regarding legislative, operational, administrative, and other concerns that have the potential to adversely impact the courts' ability to function at optimal capacity.

In its review of the reports, the workgroup will determine if there are any discernible trends with respect to the concerns and issues contained therein. The workgroup will formulate recommendations based on the trends or other critical issues it deems appropriate. Each recommendation should include the budgetary impact, if any, as well as a timeline for implementation. Additionally, each recommendation should include the Judicial Council committee to which it should be assigned, if applicable.

In addition to formulating recommendations from its review of the State of the Court reports, the workgroup will make recommendations regarding the future of Maryland's trial courts over the next five years. The workgroup will focus its attention on how to optimize the effectiveness and efficiency of the operation and administration of the trial courts. The recommendations will include any proposed legislative and or rule changes necessary to move the courts in the proposed direction.
