### Questions/Responses No. 2 to the Request for Proposals (RFP) K16-0091-50 and K16-0068-59 Worcester and St. Mary's Courtroom Benches

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The following questions for the above referenced RFP were received by e-mail and are answered and posted for all prospective Offerors. The statements and interpretations contained in the following responses to questions are not binding on the Maryland Judiciary unless the RFP is expressly amended. Nothing in the Maryland Judiciary's response to these questions is to be construed as agreement to or acceptance by the Maryland Judiciary of any statement or interpretation on the part of the Offeror asking the question.

4. **Question:** For Courtroom #1 as well as the Waiting Room, the existing benches appear to be a Maple wood species as opposed to Oak (based on the appearance of the grain). Should these 2 areas be priced in a Maple wood species, or Oak as outlined in the RFQ (knowing the grain in Oak will appear slightly different)?

**Response:** Courtroom 1 must match the existing species. Waiting area should be Red Oak; The floor plan for Courtroom # 1 says Maple.
