**Addendum No. 2 to the Multi-Step Request for Bid (RFB)  
High Density Filing System for  
New District Courthouse in Charles County  
K10-0103-84F

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This Addendum is being issued to amend and clarify certain information contained in the above named RFB. All information contained herein is binding on all Offerors who respond to this RFB. Specific parts of the RFB have been amended. The following changes/additions are listed below; new language has been underlined and language deleted has been marked with a ~~strikeout~~ (ex. ~~language deleted~~).

1. Remove Section 1.7-A - Quality Assurance (Section II Specifications), as follows:

1.7 QUALITY ASSURANCE

~~A. Manufacturer Qualifications: Engage an experienced manufacturer who is ISO 9001 certified for the design, production, installation and service of carriage mounted high density mobile storage units and support rails. Furnish certificate attesting manufacturer's ISO 9001 quality system registration.~~

2. Remove Section 2.3-A - Grout (Section II Specifications), as follows:

2.1 GROUT

~~A. General: Provide non-shrink, non-staining hydraulic cement compound conforming to the following requirements, based on the performance of the test specimens at room temperature and in laboratory air.~~

~~1. Linear Movement: No shrinkage while setting; maximum expansion limited to .002 inches per linear inch.~~

~~2. Compressive Strength: Based on two inch cubes made following ASTM standards, tested on a Balding Southward machine of 60,000 pounds capacity, meet or exceed the following:~~

~~a. Age: 1 hour — 4,500 psi  
7 days — 8,000 psi~~

3. Revise Section 2.4-E.3 - Manufactured Components: Accessories (Section II Specifications), as follows:

2.4 MANUFACTURED COMPONENTS

E. Accessories:

- ~~3. Mechanical Sweep and Safety Stop (Non-Powered).~~

4. Remove Section 2.4-E.4 - Manufactured Components: Accessories (Section II Specifications), as follows:

2.4 MANUFACTURED COMPONENTS

E. Accessories:

- ~~4. Provide 6" drawers to accommodate storage of CD-ROMs. Drawers should occupy approximately 15% of the overall capacity of the system.~~

5. Revise Section 2.4-E.5 - Manufactured Components: Accessories (Section II Specifications), as follows:

2.4 MANUFACTURED COMPONENTS

E. Accessories:

- ~~1. Provide "Store Front" storage at the end of each aisle in place of a standard face panel. A laminate panel should surround the drive handle with the area above and below the drive handle occupied by shelving.~~

6. Remove Section 3.1-B - Examination (Section II Specifications), as follows:

3.1 EXAMINATION

- ~~B. Verify that building structural system is adequate for installing mobile storage units at locations indicated on approved shop drawings.~~

7. Revise Section C - Duration of Contract (Section II Specifications), as follows:

Once awarded, the Contract shall remain in force until December 31, 2010 in the event additional components are required. All work must be completed by July 15, 2010.
