## Implemented effective January 26, 2017

## Benefits include:

- Documents accepted through e-recording or through traditional paper submission
- Increased efficiency and improved accuracy with automation that includes processing by the Treasurer's Office
- Integrated, electronic book/page numbering regardless of method of document submission
- Convenience, with system availability 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- Full integration with the ELROI Land Records system and mdlandrec.net
- Document transfer to State Archives for online public access and permanent preservation

Electronic book/page numbering (Implemented in Washington County April 1, 2016.):

Regardless of whether a document is submitted electronically, or in paper form and then scanned, book and page number is applied electronically to the stored image only. An original paper document no longer reflects the book/page reference.
