(a) All courts in the Maryland Judiciary, court offices, and administrative offices

shall be closed Friday, July 5, 2019, consistent with the Governor's decision

to extend the Independence Day holiday and close executive branch offices

and agencies; and

(b) Normal operating hours will resume on Monday, July 8, 2019.
