ORDER

WHEREAS, the County Administrative Judge for the Circuit Court for Garrett County submitted a detailed plan for the establishment of an Adult Drug Treatment Court to the Judicial Council’s Committee on Specialty Courts and Dockets for its review and recommendation in compliance with Maryland Rule 16-207 and the Administrative Order on the Approval of Problem-Solving Court Programs in the Circuit and District Courts; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Judicial Council’s Committee on Specialty Courts and Dockets, the State Court Administrator reviewed the plan and recommends its establishment to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Maryland,

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Article IV, § 18, of the Maryland Constitution, I do hereby order this 4th day of March 2026, effective immediately, that the establishment of the Adult Drug Treatment Court in the Circuit Court for Garrett County be, and hereby is, approved.
