CLERKSHIPS

Judge Beachley employs one law clerk each term, typically beginning and ending in late August or early September. His team consists of a Senior Law Clerk, a Term Law Clerk, and a Judicial Assistant. The Term Law Clerk position is full-time with a yearly salary of \$64,884.00.

Beginning March 1, 2023, Judge Beachley will be accepting applications for the 2024/25 term. Candidates should forward the following material in PDF format (preferably a single PDF) to his Judicial Assistant, Levora Cherry, at levora.cherry@mdcourts.gov: cover letter, resume, transcript (unofficial is acceptable), two writing samples, a list of three references and any letters of recommendation (letters can be sent separately). The hiring process includes an interview with the judge and will be scheduled on a rolling basis until the position is filled. Term law clerks must sit for the bar exam prior to starting their clerkship.

Judge Beachley's chambers are located in Hagerstown, Washington County, Maryland. This clerkship may be of particular interest to candidates who enjoy outdoor activities such as hiking, cycling, and kayaking as the C&O Canal National Historical Park and the Appalachian Trail are within twenty minutes of the judge's chambers.
