NATURE AND VARIETY OF WORK:

The incumbent, under the direction of the Family Support Services Coordinator will conduct custody investigations and home inspections in contested child custody and adoption cases and provide the Court with a written assessment and recommendation when appropriate.

EXAMPLES OF WORK:

Duties include but are not limited to: conducting custody investigation and home inspections in contested custody and adoption cases; assessing home conditions; preparing written assessments for court hearings; testifying in court; maintaining communication with community professionals in order to monitor referrals and program outcomes; maintaining case files with appropriate forms, evaluations, and other records. Performs other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from an accredited college or university or equivalent program as determined by the Maryland State Board of Social Work Examiners with a Master's Degree in Social Work plus two (2) years Post Masters experience providing social work services.

Licensure as a Maryland licensed certified social worker-clinical (LCSW-C) or a clinical social worker (LCSW) with an equivalent level of licensure in any other states is required OR a Maryland licensed graduate (LGSW) or master level social worker with at least two years of experience in (a) the areas of domestic violence; or child neglect and abuse; or family conflict and dynamics; or child and adult development; or impact or divorce and separation on children and adults; (b) performing custody evaluations, or (c) any combination of subsections (a) or (b); or a graduate or master social worker with an equivalent level of licensure and experience in any other state OR a Maryland licensed clinical professional counselor (LCPC) or a clinical professional counselor with an equivalent of level of licensure in any other state. Ability to interview and assess human service needs of a diverse population of individuals seeking assistance from the court on family law relates issues. Knowledge of community resources and ability to interact effectively with community service providers, make and follow up on referrals. Have excellent organizational and record keeping skills, ability to interact professionally with individuals in the court, public officials, co-workers and colleagues. Possess excellent communication skills.
