OBTAINING A MARRIAGE LICENSE

Applicants must apply and receive their marriage license in the county in which they are being married.

- ► Carroll County applicants <u>must</u> be married in Carroll County.
- Only one party need be present to apply. A valid state issued ID is required for <u>BOTH</u> parties.
- ► There is a \$ 35.00 fee for the issuance of the license.
- ➤ A license is not effective until 6:00 a.m. on the **2nd calendar day** after the license is issued, unless otherwise specified on the license.
- ➤ The license is issued the same day in which the application is received, and it is valid for **6 months**. (The parties must be married within 6 months or the license will expire.)
- ► If it is not convenient to visit the Clerk's Office in the county where the marriage is to take place, then the parties may apply for a license using a Non-Resident Marriage License Application-Affidavit Form (fillable PDF) located on the

- ► Social Security Number (mandatory)
- Applicants who have been previously married <u>must</u> provide:
 - The state and date of each divorce or death of a spouse (include the month, day & year)
 - Supporting documents if it has been less than 30 days since the divorce or death.
