ORDER

By the Court's May 7, 2020 Order, attorney Linwood Hedgepeth (AIS No. 7911010159) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rule 19-605. Attorney Hedgepeth has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rule 19-606(c), and the Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Hedgepeth's compliance with Rule 19-605.

Accordingly, it is this 21st day of January 2026, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,

ORDERED that attorney Linwood Hedgepeth (AIS No. 7911010159) is restored to good standing by the Court and is again permitted to practice law in the State of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall send notice in accordance with Rule 19-761.
