ORDER

By the Court's April 3, 2026 Order, attorneys Paul B. Dewolfe Jr., (AIS No.8005010045) and Jeanette Pfothenauer (AIS 8806010280) were prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409(c). Attorneys Dewolfe and Pfothenauer have now requested reinstatement pursuant to that Rule, and the Administrative Office of the Courts has confirmed their compliance with Rule 19-409(c).

By the Court's April 3, 2026 Order, attorney Ryland M. Sumner (AIS No.0712120324) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409(c) and 19-503. Attorney Sumner has now requested reinstatement pursuant to those Rules, and the Administrative Office of the Courts has confirmed attorney Sumner's compliance with Rules 19-409(c) and 19-503(c)(6).

Accordingly, it is this 22nd day of April 2026, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,
ORDERED that attorneys:

Paul B. Dewolfe Jr. (AIS No.5005010045),
Jeanette Pfothenauer (AIS No.8806010280), and
Ryland M. Sumner (AIS No.0712120324)

are restored to good standing by the Court and is again permitted to practice law in the State of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall send notice in accordance with Rule 19-761.
