ORDER

By the Court's March 20, 2014 Order, attorney Pallavi Rai (AIS No. 0206190187) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409, 19-503, and 19-605. Attorney Rai has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rules 19-409(c)(5)(F), 19-503(c)(6), and 19-606(c), and the Administrative Office of the Courts and the Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Rai's compliance with Rules 19-409, 19-503, and 19-605.

By the Court's April 3, 2026 Order, attorney Bruce S. Lamdin (AIS No. 7212010143) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409, 19-503, and 19-605. Attorney Lamdin has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rules 19-409(c)(5)(F), 19-503(c)(6), and 19-606(c), and the Administrative Office of the Courts and the Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Lamdin's compliance with Rules 19-409, 19-503, and 19-605.

Accordingly, it is this 5th day of May 2026, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,
ORDERED that attorneys:

Pallavi Rai (AIS No. 0206190187), and

Bruce S. Lamdin (AIS No. 721201143)

are restored to good standing by the Court and are again permitted to practice law in the State of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall send notice in accordance with Rule 19-761.
