ORDER

By the Court's March 20, 2025 Order, attorney Wayne J. King (AIS No.0712110411) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409(c). Attorney King has now requested reinstatement pursuant to that Rule, and the Administrative Office of the Courts has confirmed attorney King's compliance with Rule 19-409(c).

By the Court's March 20, 2025 Order, attorney Margaret O. Todd (AIS No. 1812120166) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rule 19-605. Attorney Todd has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rule 19-606(c), and the Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Todd's compliance with Rule 19-605.

By the Court's April 3, 2026 Order, attorney Carrie H. Allen (AIS No. 9512130022) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409(c). Attorney Allen has now requested reinstatement pursuant to that Rule, and the Administrative Office of the Courts has confirmed attorney Allen's compliance with Rule 19-409(c).

By the Court's April 3, 2026 Order, attorney Robert S. Corish (AIS No.8101010002) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rule 19-503. Attorney Corish has now requested reinstatement pursuant to those Rules, and the Administrative Office of the Courts has confirmed attorney Corish's compliance with Rule 19-503(c)(6).

Accordingly, it is this 28th day of May 2026, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,

ORDERED that attorneys:

Wayne J. King (AIS No. 0712110411),

Margaret O. Todd (AIS No. 1812120166),

Carrie H. Allen (AIS No. 9512130022), and

Robert S. Corish (AIS No. 8101010002)

are restored to good standing by the Court and is again permitted to practice law in the State of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall send notice in accordance with Rule 19-761.
