FINAL ORDER OF RATIFICATION

This Court's October 27, 2025 Order *Nisi* as to candidate Natalie Tverdynin was entered and posted on the Judiciary's website pursuant to Rule 19-211(a)(2). The State Board of Law Examiners (the "Board") recommended Ms. Tverdynin for admission to the Bar of Maryland, subject to her satisfaction of the conditions identified in that order. The Order further provided that it would be ratified as to Ms. Tverdynin, effective on November 26, 2025 unless the Court received an exception as to her by that date. No exceptions to the Board's recommendation have been filed as to Ms. Tverdynin.

Accordingly, it is this 26th day of November 2025, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,

ORDERED that the Board's recommendation for admission of Natalie Tverdynin, filed in this Court on October 27, 2025, is ratified as of November 26, 2025; and it is further

ORDERED that after passing character approval and satisfying the requirements of Rule 19-212 (Maryland Law Component) and 19-213 (Qualifying MPRE Score Required) Natalie Tverdynin will be admitted to practice law in this Court upon taking the oath prescribed by the statute.
