ORDER OF RATIFICATION

After the Court's October 2, 2025 Order *Nisi* was issued and posted, the Court received exceptions as to candidate Amir Hossein Arab Zadeh. Pursuant to Rule 19-211(b), the exceptions were referred to the State Board of Law Examiners for proceedings under Rule 19-204. The State Board has notified the Court that Mr. Arab Zadeh has been cleared for admission to the bar and fulfilled all requirements necessary to take the oath.

Accordingly, it is this 21st day of April 2026, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,

ORDERED that the Board's recommendation for admission of Amir Hossein Arab Zadeh is ratified as of April 21, 2026 and he will be admitted to practice law in this Court upon taking the oath prescribed by the statute.
