FINAL ORDER OF RATIFICATION

This Court's March 27, 2026 Order *Nisi* was entered and posted on the Judiciary's website pursuant to Rule 19-211(a)(2). That Order identified individuals who the State Board of Law Examiners (the "Board") recommended for admission to the Bar of Maryland, subject to each applicant's satisfaction of identified conditions. The Order further provided that it would be ratified as to each identified applicant, effective on April 27, 2026, unless the Court received an exception as to that applicant by that date. No exceptions to the Board's recommendation have been filed as to any applicant.

Accordingly, it is this 29th day of April 2026, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,

ORDERED that the recommendations for admission of the Uniform Bar Exam applicants (Rule 19-211(a)) to the Bar of Maryland contained in the Board's report, filed in this Court on March 27, 2026, are ratified as of April 27, 2026; and it is further

ORDERED that the applicants recommended in the Board's report who have passed character approval and have satisfied the requirements of Rule 19-212 (Maryland Law Component) and 19-213 (Qualifying MPRE Score Required) will be admitted to practice law in this Court upon taking the oath prescribed by the statute.
