July 6, 2020: Howard County residents may apply for rental or mortgage assistance. It may cover up to three months of housing expenses.

To apply, you will need

- 1. Proof of where you live.
- 2. Evidence of income loss due to COVID may be due to the loss of a job, a reduction in hours, and/or days missed because someone was sick
