- Abide by the Maryland Standards of Conduct for Court-Designated Arbitrators, Fact finders, Neutral Evaluators, and Settlement Conference practitioners, (eff. 01/01/20);
- Submit to periodic monitoring by a qualified person designated by the ADR Office;
- Comply with the procedures and requirements posted on the ADR
 Office's website relating to diligence and quality assurance; and,
- Complete 8 hours of ADR-related continuing education every two years (encouraged).
