

You may create an account to view a case in which you a party. When you register to view a case, you will have access to the court docket showing activity in the case, as well as to documents filed in the case.

Registering to view a case does not give you the ability to e-file. If you choose to register as an e-filer, you will need to file all documents in all cases electronically going forward. By registering to view only, you are not required to e-file at this time or in the future.

There are two (2) parts to registering to view a case: 1) Register on the website and 2) Submit a signed and notarized application to the court.



## Part 1 – Registering on the Website

 Open your web browser and navigate to the Maryland Judiciary Record Search Portal. (<a href="https://mdecportal.courts.state.md.us/MDODYSSEYPORTAL">https://mdecportal.courts.state.md.us/MDODYSSEYPORTAL</a>).



2. You must be a party to a case to view case documents electronically.



3. Click **Register / Sign In** on the top right of the page.




4. Click Register.





5. You must provide your personal information to register for an account.



6. Enter your **First Name**, your **Last Name**, your **Email Address**, a **password**, your **cell phone number**, and your cell phone provider.

**Note**: Passwords must have at least eight letters, one special character, one uppercase letter, and one number.



7. Choose three (3) security questions and provide answers in their respective fields to the right of each question.





8. Enter the letters and numbers you see in the field below. Click Next.




9. Registration is not complete until you verify your email address. The system will send you an email for you to confirm your email address.



10. Click the **Maryland Judiciary Record Search** link within the email to verify your email address.



11. Your account is now validated.





## Part 2 - Submitting a Signed and Notarized Application to the Court

12. Download and complete the Application for Party Access to MDEC Cases (MDJ-004). **Note**: If you need to view cases in more than one court, you will need a new form for each court.

14. Submit in person or by mail your completed and notarized <u>Application for Party Access</u> to <u>MDEC Cases (MDJ-004)</u> to the court in which you would like to view a case. Find the address of the court in the directory here: <a href="https://www.mdcourts.gov/courtsdirectory">https://www.mdcourts.gov/courtsdirectory</a>.



15. If your application is **approved**, you will be notified by email and then you can remotely access documents in the case requested. If your application is **denied**, you will not have online access, and you will be notified by email of the reason.
