*This is a per curiam opinion. Under Rule 1-104, the opinion is not precedent within the rule of stare decisis, nor may it be cited as persuasive authority.

In September 2025, Arthur Wiggins, appellant, filed in each of his cases in the Circuit Court for Baltimore City a motion to correct commitment record. Instead of denying the motions, the court forwarded to Mr. Wiggins copies of orders, issued in November 2024, in which the court denied previously filed motions to correct commitment record. Mr. Wiggins now challenges the court’s action. But, Mr. Wiggins does not cite any authority that classifies the action as a final judgment from which he may appeal. *See* Md. Code (1974, 2020 Repl. Vol., 2025 Supp.), § 12-301 of the Courts & Judicial Proceedings Article (generally, “a party may appeal from [only] a final judgment entered in a civil or criminal case by a circuit court”). Hence, we dismiss the appeal.
