Appellants noted this appeal from the circuit court’s denial of their petition to compel arbitration. In the meantime, they have filed a motion to stay the trial before the circuit court in this matter, which is scheduled to commence in seven days. We have thoroughly reviewed the record and conclude that the circuit court did not err in denying appellants’ petition to compel arbitration. We agree, in the words of that court, that this is not the “type of action [which] falls within arbitration,” and that it is “specifically excluded from arbitration” by the arbitration agreements at issue. Accordingly, we affirm the circuit court’s order denying appellants’ request to compel arbitration and deny appellants’ motion to stay proceedings pending in the circuit court. We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this Court and argument would not aid in the decisional process.
